

Breaking the News gets behind the upheaval of the last four years in East Timor to reveal the high cost for truth-seeking journalists at the centre of their country's turmoil.

Eleven years since the East Timorese successfully voted for independence from Indonesia, Breaking the News gets behind the scenes of news and current affairs reportage to challenge those who think a free press automatically comes with independence. What happens to the local journalists when the foreign reporters return safely home after covering each crisis, their stories in the can? Jose Belo and Rosa Garcia are two local journalists enmeshed in the political turmoil of their country, who regularly put themselves and their families at risk by reporting ongoing corruption and injustice. The film was nominated for the Independent Spirit IF Award at the 2011 IF Awards Australia.
